

HOW TO RETURN YOUR **MAIL-IN BALLOT**




1. COMPLETE YOUR BALLOT

Read the instructions carefully and mark your ballot. Be sure to complete the front and back of each page.




2. SECRECY ENVELOPE

Seal your ballot in the inner secrecy envelope that indicates "official election ballot."



3. OUTER RETURN ENVELOPE


Seal the inner secrecy envelope in the pre-addressed outer return envelope.



4. SIGN AND DATE IT

Complete, sign and date the voter's declaration on the outside of the outer return envelope.





RETURN IN-PERSON



DROP BOX

Return your voted ballot to the county election board. Mail ballots must be received by 8 p.m. on election day by your county board of elections. To ensure your ballot is received by the deadline, return the ballot as soon as possible.

NOTICE: For your vote to count, you must return your ballot in the inner secrecy envelope that indicates official election ballot AND the pre-addressed outer return envelope where you must sign, by the deadline. You must return your own ballot unless you are a voter with a disability who has designated an agent in writing.
